Thanks to all who participated in the OUR CITY 2041 QUIZ!

A total of eight quizzes were submitted and reviewed. Community members demonstrated their knowledge of the Official Community Plan, and their memory of the OUR CITY 2041 process.

Three people scored the highest: 13 out of 15 total points and were entered into the draw.

1. Staff stood out in the crowd at OCP events by wearing brightly coloured t-shirts.

Name one colour of the staff t-shirts:

Answer: ORANGE OR YELLOW. Staff were never lost in the crowd.

2. The City made buttons to hand out at different events, often at the pop-up planning booths. **How many different OUR CITY buttons were designed?**

Answer: 14. How many did you collect?

6. There are twelve Policy Areas (chapters) in the OCP. Which three of the following are Policy Areas?

B. PUBLIC REALM & URBAN DESIGN

C. Zombie & Apocalypse Preparedness

D. HOUSING

E. HERITAGE

F. Flood Management

Strengthened Connections is one of the seven themes that runs throughout the OCP. Flood Management is a Policy Area in the Queensborough Community Plan. Zombie & Apocalypse Preparedness was not addressed in this OCP.

7. We heard from you that the OCP needs to balance two key objectives. What are **the two focus areas** of this OCP? (Fill in the blank.)

Accommodating **GROWTH**Increasing Housing **CHOICE**

We heard from the public that while accommodating growth is important to the city's future, we must balance that with ensuring there are diverse housing opportunities.

8. The OCP is a plan for the future, looking towards what year?

Answer: 2041.

9. **True or False:** The lead planner on the OCP is named Linda Roxbury?

Answer: FALSE. Lynn Roxburgh was the lead planner on the OCP.

10. The New West Museum currently has an exhibit on Planning in New Westminster that explores the City's planning history. **How many OCPs have there been in the history of the City** (not including neighbourhood plans)?

Answer: THREE. This OCP is the City's third. The first OCP was adopted in 1983, and the second in 1998. However, there was a major OCP update and adoption bylaw in 2011, so we also accepted four as correct answer.
