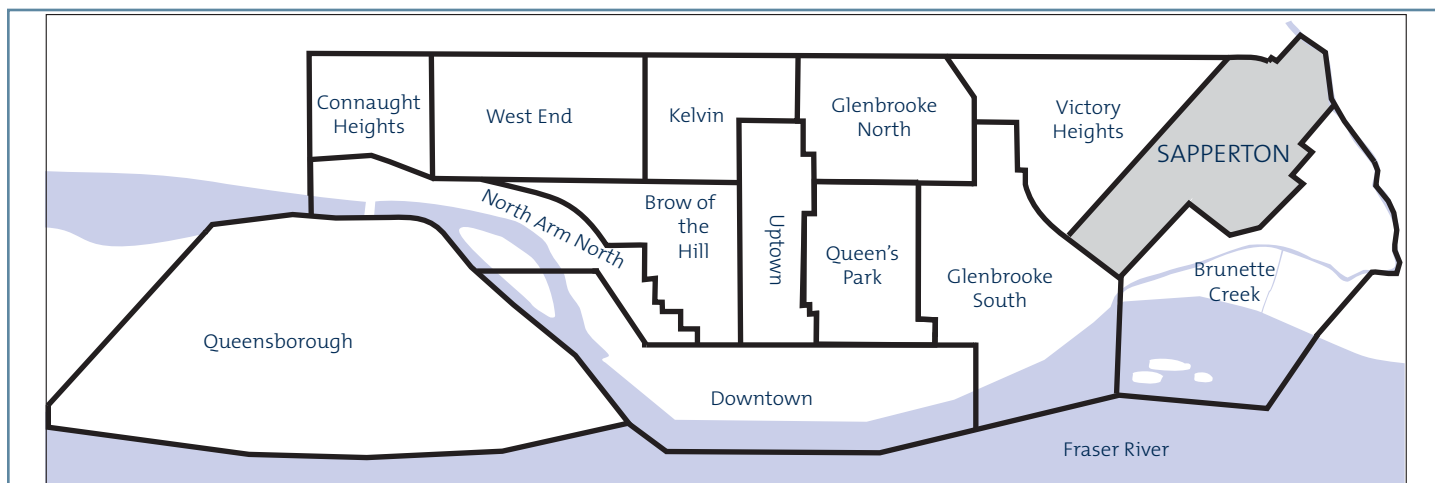

All data in tables, charts, and text is from Statistics Canada, based on the 2006 and 2001 Census. References in the text to “more”, “fewer”, or “similar” are all based on comparisons with Census figures for the City of New Westminster as a whole. Distinct Neighbourhood Features

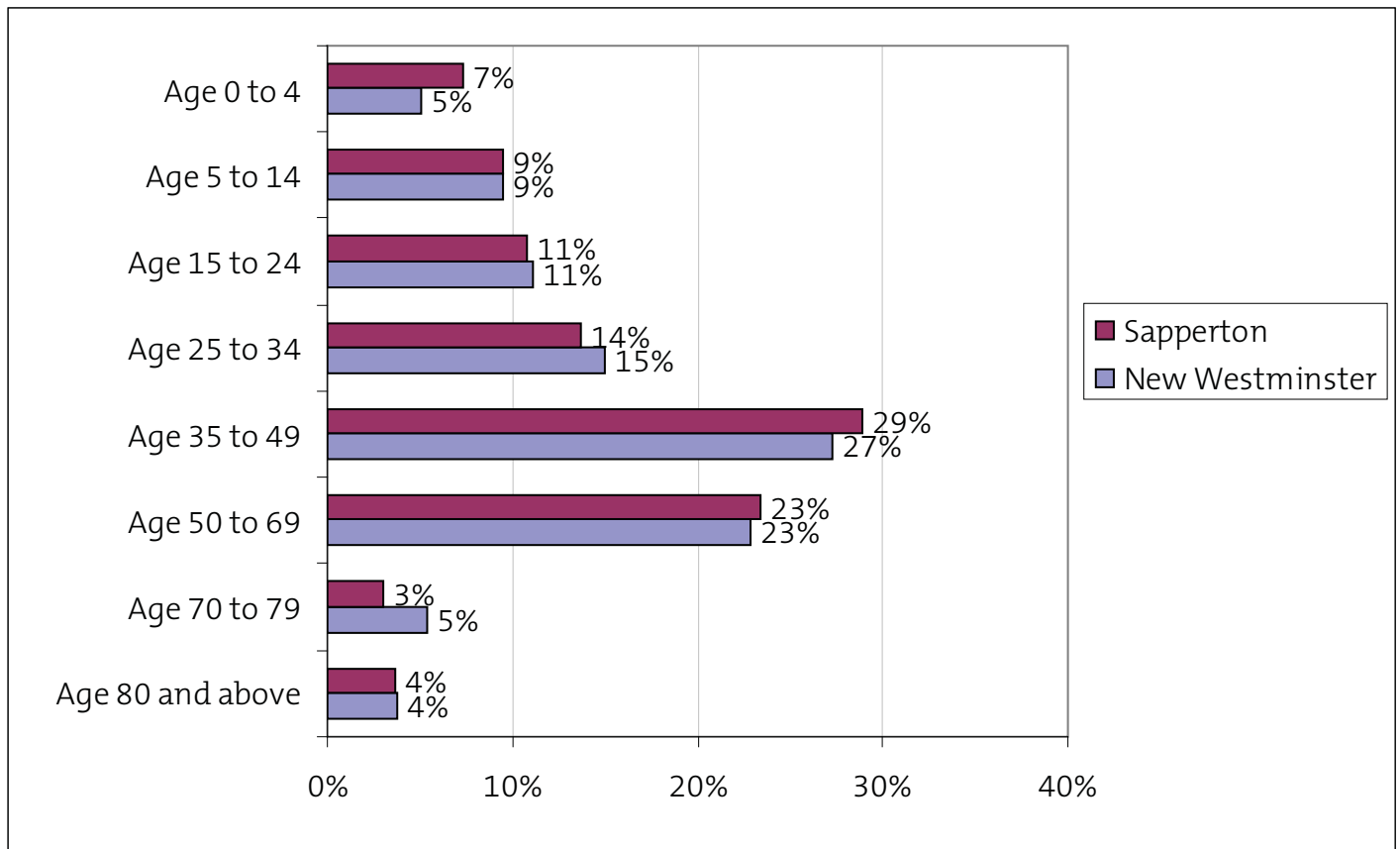
Sapperton is a slower growing part of the City, showing just a 2% increase in population between 2001 and 2006. Its age profile is very similar to the City's, with slightly fewer young children and seniors aged 70-79, and slightly more adults aged 35-49. There are more couples with children, and significantly fewer total households have moved within the last 5 years. It has a slightly higher median household income than the City. There is a diverse mix of housing types, with the exact same proportion of owner/renter households as the City. Fewer renter households struggle with affordability. More residents work in business/finance/administration and health, and fewer work in sales and service. English is more prevalent as a home language, spoken by 83% of residents in Sapperton vs. 79% City-wide. The Philippines is the most significant source country of immigrants, both overall and particularly in relation to recent immigrants. Bulgaria is also a notable source country of recent immigrants, and after English, Bulgarian is the second most common home language.

- Total population is up 2.2% since 2001, compared with 7.5% City-wide.
- Sapperton makes up 7.8% of the City's population.
- Compared to the City, Sapperton has 2% more children aged 4 and under, 2% more aged 35 to 49, and 2% fewer aged 70 to 79.

Population & Age Groups



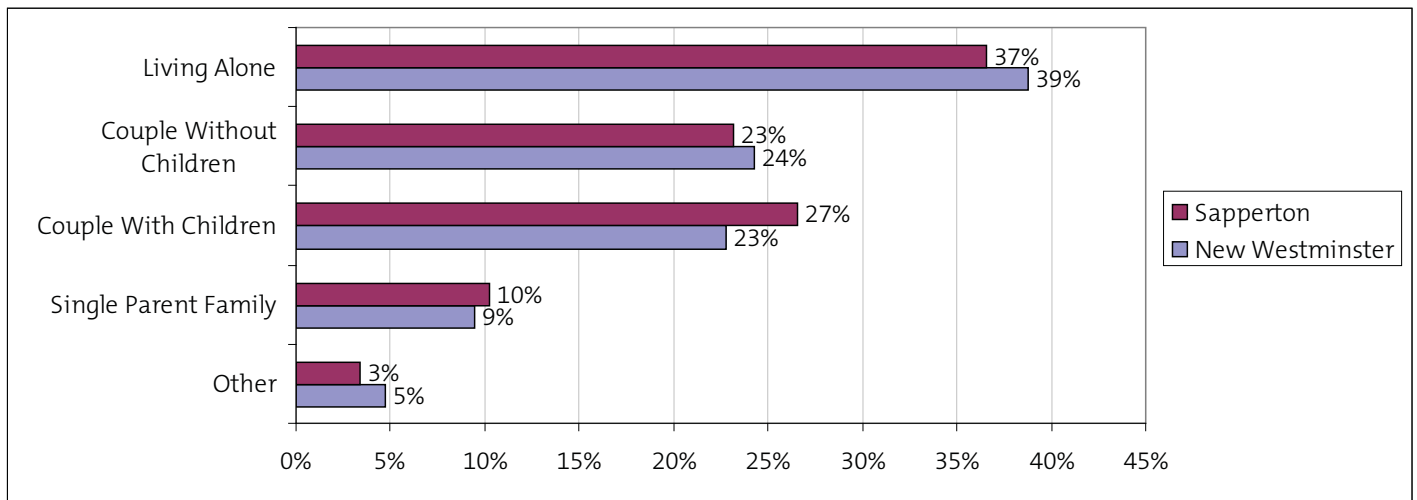

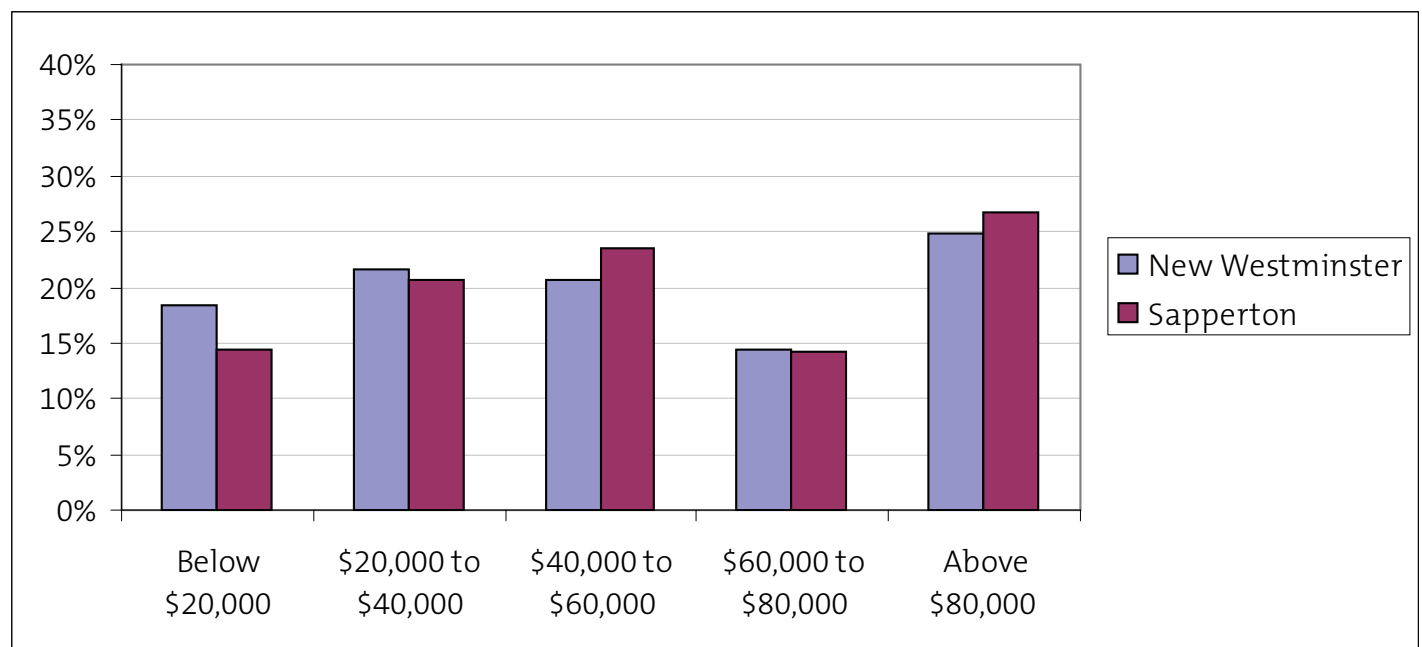
- Sapperton's household mix has 4% more couples with children, and 2% fewer persons living alone.
- In Sapperton, 11% fewer households have moved within the last 5 years.

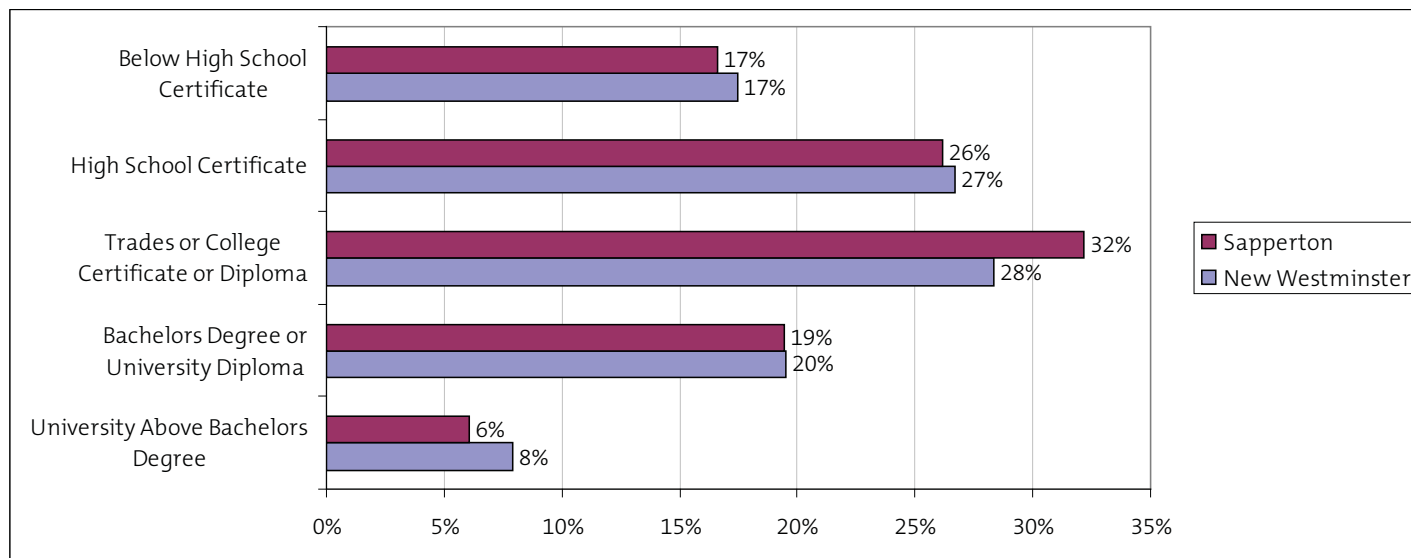
- Sapperton's income profile is very similar to the City-wide pattern. Compared to the City, in Sapperton there are 4% fewer households in the lowest income category, and 3% more in the \$40,000 to \$60,000 income category.
- Sapperton's median household income is 3% higher than the City's. There is also a slightly lower prevalence of low income (18%), about 2% below the City-wide rate.

- There is a diverse mix of housing in the neighbourhood. Households living in apartments comprise a 25% lower share than City-wide. The share of households living in single family homes is 15% higher than City-wide. Houses with secondary suites are also more common in Sapperton.
- Sapperton's mix of owner vs. renter households is identical to the City's. 33% of renter households struggle with affordability, which is 6% lower than the City-wide rate. There is a slightly higher share of owners facing affordability challenges.

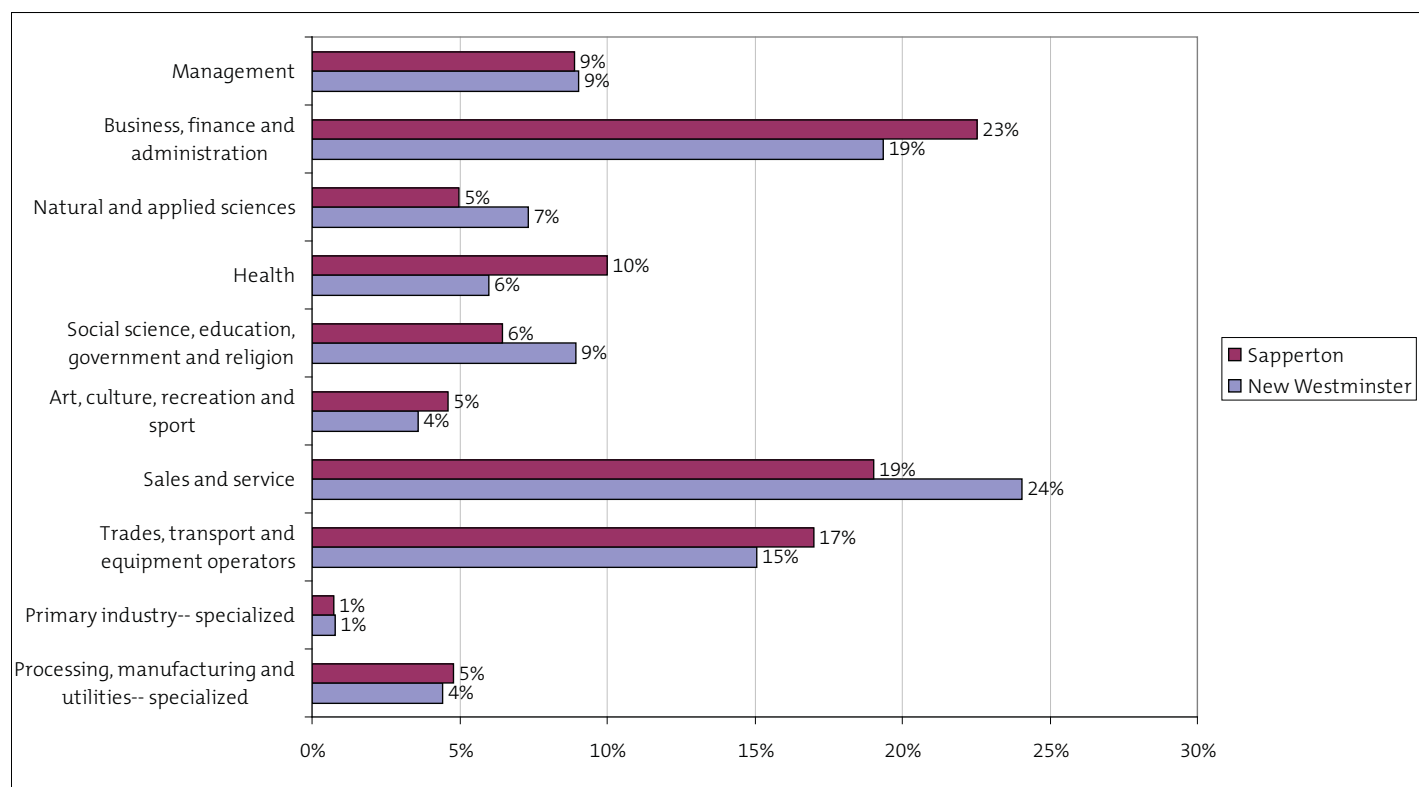
- Sapperton has a 4% higher share of persons with a trades/ college diploma, and a 2% lower share of residents with university education above the Bachelor's level.
- Sapperton's labour force participation rate is 3% higher than the City's. It has the same unemployment rate as the City.
- Business, finance, and administration is the most common occupational group for Sapperton residents.

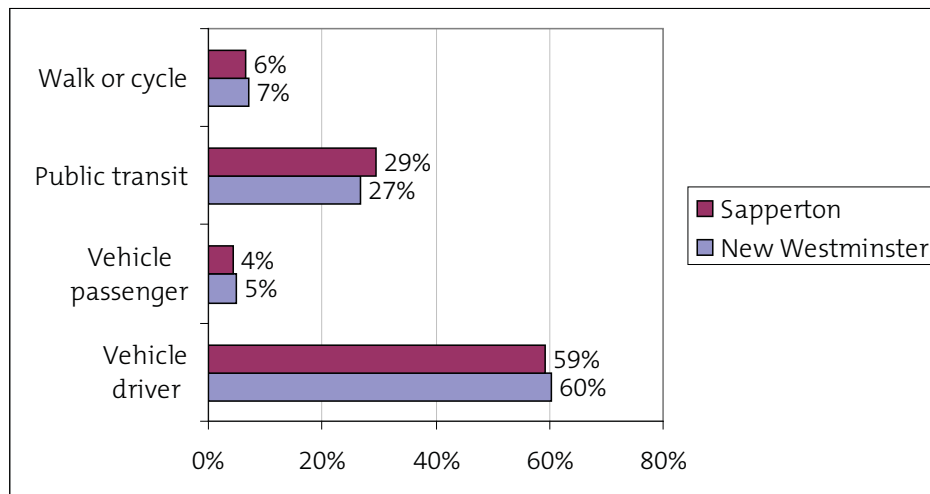

- In Sapperton, there are several differences in occupations compared to the City: 5% fewer residents employed in sales and service; 4% more in business, finance and administration; 4% more in health; and 3% fewer in social science, education, and government.

Mode of Travel to Work



- Sapperton residents are 2% more likely to take transit to work.
- Transit's share of work trips is up 15% since 2001*, vs. 7% for the City.
- Vehicle driving's share is down 11% since 2001, vs. 5% for the City.

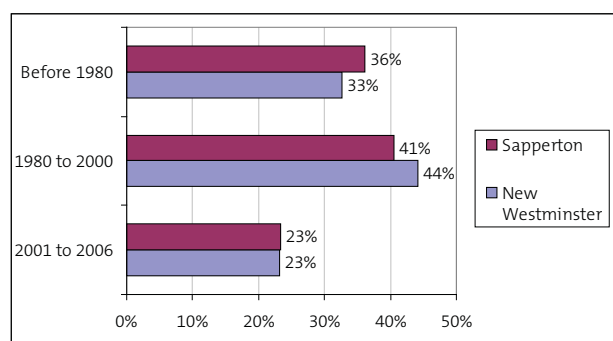
- Compared to the City, Filipino, Ukrainian, and Dutch ethnic origins are more common in Sapperton. Chinese origins are less common.
- English is 4% more prevalent in Sapperton. It dropped 4% in prevalence between 2001-2006 in Sapperton but increased by 3% City-wide during the same period. English is still predominant, with over 82% of residents using it as their home language.
- Bulgarian is distinct as the second most common home language in Sapperton. Korean, Filipino, and Mandarin have the same share and prominence both City-wide and in Sapperton.

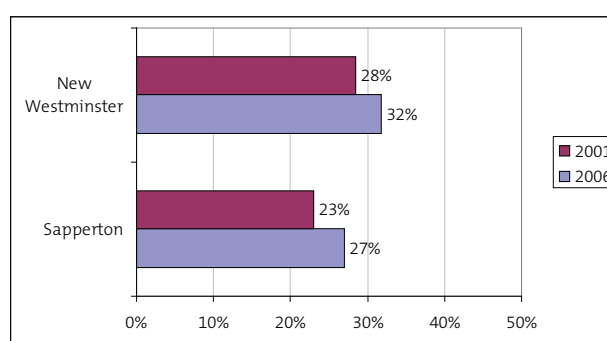

- Compared to the City, Canadian citizens make up a 3% higher proportion of the population in Sapperton.
- Immigrants make up a 4% lower share of the population.
- Compared to the City-wide profile, the Philippines is a much more significant source country of immigrants in Sapperton, with an 11% higher share of total immigrants. Taiwan, and Trinidad and Tobago are also more prominent source countries in this neighbourhood.
- Among recent immigrants, the Philippines is even more prominent as a source country. Almost half (47%) of all recent immigrants living in Sapperton are from the Philippines. Although this country is also ranked first City-wide in relation to recent immigrants, by proportion the Philippines has a 31% higher share in Sapperton. Bulgaria is also distinct, accounting for 26% of recent immigrants in Sapperton. China is less prominent, with an 11% lower share of recent immigrants compared to the City.
- Between 2001-2006, the share of immigrants in the City and in Sapperton grew at the same rate.
- Immigrants in Sapperton were 3% more likely to have come to Canada before 1980.

The Census uses "random rounding" in its data, to round numbers either up or down to multiples of 5. Because of this, some figures differ slightly. For example, New Westminster population may be shown as either 57,850 or 57,845. Both totals can be considered correct and accurate.
